## STEEL SPORTS ACADEMY GUIDELINES

Welcome back to Baseball Heaven and the Steel Sports Academy! As we return to play, our Kids First philosophy extends out to every person who visits our facility, and our No. 1 priority is ensuring everyone's health and safety. In order to accomplish this, everyone must do their part to return to play responsibly by learning and following our new ground rules.

### THE COMMON FIVE

- **Hand Washing** – We recommend you wash your hands often, and when soap and water is not available, we have hand sanitizer placed throughout the facility for your frequent use.
- **Social Distancing** – Please always maintain at least 6 feet between you and others, following all posted signage throughout the facility.
- **Face Coverings** – Please follow all guidelines below regarding masks or face coverings inside the facility. These guidelines are non-negotiable to ensure we keep our facility open.
- **Cleaning & Disinfecting** – Please be patient as our staff performs more frequent cleaning and disinfecting. Help do your part by keeping your area clean and disposing of trash.
- **Health Monitoring** – Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should **STAY HOME** and contact a local health care facility immediately. **STAY HOME IF YOU ARE NOT FEELING WELL!**

### FACILITY GUIDELINES

- The Steel Sports Academy will always have no more than 25% capacity.
- All patrons must come through the main door and exit out the back door (nearest the parking lot) of the facility to limit the flow of traffic.
- All patrons must wear a mask when entering the facility.
- All patrons must fill out the COVID-19 questionnaire, have their temperature taken with a no contact device and sign the waiver form. Steel Sports may deny entrance into the building if they do not meet the guidelines.
- Clients are limited to one (1) parent/guardian inside the facility (one parent and one child). Parents/guardians must always wear a mask inside the facility. **PLEASE NOTE:** NO siblings.
- A parent/guardian must accompany kids 13 and younger into the facility. This is optional for kids 14 and older.
- Reservations must be made prior to entering the facility. Walk-ins will not be accepted.
- After every hour of instruction, the facility will be closed for 10-15 minutes for sanitation.
- NO food allowed inside the facility.
- Parents/guardians must always sit socially distanced from others.
- Only four (4) cages will be in operation at a time (two on each side).



## **INSTRUCTION**

- Both the instructor and player must pass the COVID-19 screening process before starting.
- Player must check-in with the indoor director upon arrival.
- NO equipment bags should be brought inside the facility. Please only bring inside the necessary equipment.
- Parents/guardians will be seated socially distanced and near their child's lesson.
- Player and instructor must be wearing a mask where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Instructors are required to wear a mask while giving a lesson.
- Player must be wearing batting gloves when in contact with any instructional equipment.
- Each batting tunnel will be provided with sanitizing equipment.
